Prior to USO, Ashley served as the Navy Region Southwest, Metro San Diego, Ombudsman Coordinator, serving as a Regional Train the Trainer and was previously the President of the San Diego Chief Petty Officer Spouse Association; these positions in, particular in combination with her own Military lifestyle experience has shown direct, immediate, positive impact allowing for positive outcomes of those who need it the most.
